

**UNIVERSITY HONORS PROGRAM: HONORS-AUGMENTED COURSE
CONTRACT**

Dear Honors student and faculty member:

Honors students are eligible to take designated sections of regular courses for Honors-Augmented credit. At the FSU Study Abroad Centers, Honors students may approach the teacher of any FSU Liberal Studies course and request permission to augment that course for Honors Credit.

To earn Honors-Augmented credit, **the Honors student must satisfactorily complete all the regular course requirements *plus* an extra research, writing, or creative project; additional readings with an appropriate evaluative component; or any other reasonable assignment on which the student and faculty member agree.** For the Honors-Augmented credit to be posted, the student must receive at least a B- for the overall course grade, additional project included.

The Honors student and faculty member must complete and sign Part 1 of this contract within the first two weeks of class. Then both must sign Part 2 of the contract when the project is completed and the final grade in the course has been calculated. **FACULTY MEMBER - please note: This form must be faxed to the FSU Honors Office after the course is completed and Part 2 has been signed.** Please feel free to make additional copies of this contract for your use.
