PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Welcome to University Honors!

The FSU Honors Program identifies intellectually curious students who have the potential, dedication, and drive for creating change and provides them with holistic development through enriching experiences in and beyond the classroom. We offer training, support, and opportunities to develop students who are scholars, leaders, innovators, and lifelong learners.

University Honors is a vibrant and engaged community of student scholars that excel both in and outside of the classroom. University Honors students focus on their social, intellectual, and personal development through academic, service, research, entrepreneurship, and leadership opportunities. The Honors Program creates unique resources designed to facilitate the success of Honors students.

As a member of University Honors, students have access to specialized Honors advisors, increased faculty interaction, and smaller classes optimized for student learning. Students can satisfy general education requirements by taking Honors sections of core courses required for their degree and may participate in select leadership and service opportunities.

Additionally, the Honors Student Association hosts engaging social and professional development events that encourage peer-to-peer relationship building.

To successfully complete University Honors, students must earn 18 Honors points through a combination of Honors courses and approved extra-curricular achievements.

RETENTION & GRADUATION

RETENTION REQUIREMENTS:

To remain in good standing with the program, University Honors students must:

- Maintain a 3.2 FSU GPA throughout the duration of their time to degree
- Take and pass Honors Colloquium (HUM 2944) during their first semester in University Honors
- Earn a C- or higher in ENC 2135 during their first academic year in Honors
- Take at least one Honors Signature course during their first academic year in Honors
- Complete at least 7 Honors credit hours by the end of their second year

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:

To complete University Honors, students must earn **18 Honors points and have a final 3.2 GPA upon graduation**. At least 13 of the Honors points must be earned through Honors course work and up to 5 points may be earned from other achievements.

Students must complete the online Honors Graduation Application by the designated date during their graduation semester.

Students who successfully complete University Honors earn the transcript distinction, "Completed Requirements of Liberal Studies Honors Program", and earn an Honors medallion.

PATHWAYS TO HONORS GRADUATION

University Students have the opportunity, but are not required to apply to and complete the Honors in the Major program. Honors distinctions vary depending on which program(s) students complete and details can be found below.

UH

University Honors

Students that complete the University Honors Program will receive a University Honors medallion and "Completed Liberal Studies Honors Program" will be placed on the final transcript.

DH

Dual Honors

Students that complete both the University Honors and Honors in the Major programs will be recognized as a Dual Honors graduate and will receive the respective medallions and recognition for each program.

OSS

Outstanding Senior Scholar

Students that complete both the University Honors and Honors in the Major programs and earn a final FSU GPA of 3.9 or higher will be recognized as an Outstanding Senior Scholar. These students will receive the respective medallions and recognition for each program and will be featured on the Honors website.

HONORS ADVISING

****Honors staff will be available during Orientation Academic Resource Sessions from 10:00 - 11:00 am and 12:00 - 1:00 pm, Monday through Thursday. To meet with an Honors staff member use the Zoom link provided in your orientation information.****

The Honors Program offers two distinct opportunities to meet with an Honors advisor during the academic year. If you have a quick question or would like to check on your Honors points progress, we recommend attending drop-in advising. If you would like to discuss a topic more in depth, we encourage you to schedule an appointment with an Honors advisor.

ADVISING APPOINTMENTS:

During the academic year, students may schedule and appointment with their preferred Honors advisor via Camus Connect. Instructions on how to schedule can be found on the Honors website. This advising opportunity is not meant to replace appointments with your academic advisor, but supplement those meetings.

DROP-IN ADVISING:

During the Fall 2021 semester, advisors will be offering drop-in advising times Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday from 8:30 - 11:30 am and 1:30 - 4:30 pm. Details on attending drop-in advising hours may be found on the Honors website at the beginning of the fall semester.

COURSE REGISTRATION

Honors classes are highly engaging, limited class size courses that provide students an intentional and accessible classroom experience. Such courses are not necessarily harder than regular courses but they tend to move at a faster pace than the corresponding non-Honors course. Due to the small class size, these courses also provide more chances for interaction between fellow classmates and between students and their professors. Honors sections of regular courses can be used to meet liberal studies requirements.

[A grade of "C-" or higher is required for the course to count toward the University Honors point requirement.]

SEARCHING FOR AN HONORS COURSE:

To search for Honors classes while in the myFSU Portal:

1. First, select the Student Central (SC) icon.
2. Next, select the "My Classes" tile on the FSU Student Homepage.
3. Select the link "Class Search."
4. Enter the Term and Student Group.
 - The Student Group for Honors courses is "HONR."
5. Click the "Search" button at the bottom of the page to show Honors courses that match your search criteria.

HONORS TIMELINE

The following timeline provides a general outline of program expectations for students based on their year of enrollment in the University Honors Program. Students must maintain a 3.2 GPA or higher during their time to degree.

First Year

- ~ Take HUM2944: Honors Colloquium during the fall semester
- ~ Take an Honors section of ENC2135
- ~ Complete at least one Honors Signature course

Second Year

- ~ Complete at least 7 Honors points

Third Year

- ~ Meet with an Honors advisor to ensure you are on track to graduate with Honors recognition
- ~ Plan to complete outstanding Honors course or achievement points

Fourth/Final Year

- ~ Complete remaining Honors points requirements
 - ~ Apply for Honors Graduation via the online application during the semester of graduation
